Sessions will take place from 3:15 – 5:00 p.m. every Tuesday starting Oct. 3 through Nov. 7. Each session will be held at the Odell Brewery Community Room and will include **networking opportunities**, **professional development** content from an expert facilitator, and **one beverage** of the participant's choosing.

Topics addressed across the program will include:

- Practical Project Management
- Emotional Intelligence
- Professional Communication

Along with facilitating the professional development sessions, Dr. Erika Michalski will be hosting 2 "Office Hours" at Horse and Dragon Brewery for participants. It will be an opportunity for individuals to get additional support or tailored insight on session content. Participants are expected to attend all professional development sessions but attending office hours is optional.
