Leadership Fort Collins, a program of the Fort Collins Area Chamber of Commerce, was established in 1981 to inform participants about the history, government, economy, social issues, needs and opportunities in our community. The goal of the program is to educate and motivate leaders who are committed to shaping the future of our community.

The program is designed to:

- Broaden participants' knowledge of the community and enhance their leadership skills.
- Encourage participants to contribute to the betterment of our community.
- Increase the strength and effectiveness of our community leaders.
- Equip participants to respond to the current and future challenges of the community.
- Provide opportunities for direct contact with influential people, businesses and organizations.

Important Information

- **Applicants must (1)** reside and/or be employed in the Fort Collins area and **(2)** be at least 21 years of age at the time of application.
- Leadership Fort Collins requires full participation. Only those willing to thoughtfully and completely fill out an application, participate in a class project and attend and participate in all nine (9) program sessions and the orientation need apply. The class will meet on the second Thursday of the month from 7:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. from September through May with the February session being on February 10 from 5:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. and Orientation being on Thursday, September 16 from 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- Class members are expected to attend each session in its entirety and will be required to spend additional time outside of class (10-20 hours) completing projects.
- Session topics throughout the year include: Growth, Environment and Community Planning; Local Government; Public Safety and Community Assistance; Economic Development and Small Business Assistance; Health Care; History, Diversity and Community Betterment; Education and Life-Long Learning; and Teambuilding and Leadership Development. Session topics may be revised by the Steering Committee to best serve the needs and goals of the participants.
- The tuition for the nine-month program is \$850 and covers all meals, session materials and graduation recognition. The tuition is due on October 14, 2021 and may be paid by the applicant, by the applicant's employer or sponsor, or a combination thereof.
- Membership in the Fort Collins Area Chamber of Commerce is not a requirement for participation in the program.
- All applicants not selected for the 2021-2022 program may apply for a future Leadership Fort Collins class, but applications are not held from year to year or automatically resubmitted.
