## **Global Adventures Welcomes Founder of African Bush Camps**

Beks Ndlovu, founder of African Bush Camps, will address the monthly gathering of *Global Adventures* from 6-8 pm Wednesday, Oct. 18, at the Global Village Museum of Arts and Cultures.

The monthly gatherings are designed for those who love to travel, want to recount their travel experiences, delight in sharing stories of travel, and/or dream of traveling one day. Bookable through Outdoor Travel Adventures for travel by the end of 2024 (excluding July-September), the two nights include accommodation, food, drink, shared game viewing, and conservation fees.
