#### BUILDING BACK BETTER FOR A STRONG NORTHERN COLORADO

The Fort Collins Area Chamber of Commerce is an essential resource for the business community. Throughout 2020 and into 2021, we have been at the forefront providing business advocacy, working with local, state and federal organizations to support local businesses of all sizes and providing information, resources and assistance to help our members survive this unprecedented economic hit.

## **PANDEMIC RESPONSE**

• Built, with partners, a unified regional COVID-19 resource for businesses NoCoRecovers.com.

NoCo Recovers

- Co-founded \$5M local business relief fund with community partners and distributed funds to over 200 businesses in Larimer County.
- Co-Convened and Leading **Reignite Northern Colorado**, an economic recovery strategy. The mission is to replace the lost regional domestic product and jobs lost during the pandemic.
- Created **Recovery Tracker** that provides insights into key aspects of Northern Colorado's economy and monitor certain indicators to track progress toward recovery.
- Gathered important data through conversations and survey work to better serve our business community in our response and recovery efforts.
- Created **Open for Business** webpage with more than 200 business listings and garnering 1,600 pages views per month.
- Co-created Larimer County's "5 star" certified business variance program, locally known as the Level Up Program. More than 360 businesses have been awarded.



• Built online marketplace to connect buyers and sellers of PPE: NoCoSafetySupply.com.

• Developed and executed **#KeepNoCoOpen** and **#ForFortCollins** campaigns with community partners.

 Continued hosting members events (virtual and in-person) for connecting, networking and professional **development.** These events included Leads groups, Fridays at the Chamber, Lunch n' Learn and Connect@Lunch.

- Reached out to all **1,200+ members** of the Chamber two times throughout 2020.
- Created a Resource and Recovery Friday email with direct information to state executive orders, resources, funding options, recovery efforts, guidelines to reopening and staying open.
- Conducted series of business webinars and regional town hall calls about **COVID-19 business relief**, including CARES Act and EIDL Loans, financial resources, reopening and keeping businesses open and marketing recovery.
- Northern Colorado Legislative Alliance hosted a series of calls with US Senators, state legislators and other business leaders. Calls included topics on transportation, energy, oil & gas, labor laws, U.S. Candidate Forum and a legislative session preview.
- · Lobbied during restarted state legislative session to **stop or neutralize** anticipated anti-business legislation.
- Advocated for local government to extend tax payment deadlines, less rigorous sign code enforcement, suspend 'time-of use' utility rates and more.
- Seat at the Table: Chamber leadership has participated in more than 1,000 phone and virtual meetings with community partners, Northern Colorado economic development organizations and state, city and co officials to provide support, perspective and a voice for business.

- Hosted 4 Signature Events on virtual platforms, including Talent Summit, Small Business Celebration, Regional Issues Summit and Cyber Security Summit. Each event had more than 100 participants and the reply videos are being viewed weekly.

  - Launched **Webinar Series** with a goal to provide presentations on timely topics that impact the business community.
  - Chamber Board of Directors established a Past Chairs Council
  - Volunteer of the Year Award renamed in honor of Valerie Arnold
  - A feasibility study was conducted for **Northern Colorado Prospers 2.0** and supported strongly by the Board to move forward.
